## Vendor Agreement

### Terms and Conditions

- I. ERIS shall provide vending space equivalent to an 8' x 10' section of space at the Fall Festival, to be held on October 15, 2005, at Schodack Island State Park, One Schodack Way, Schodack Landing, NY 12156. (Electrical outlets are not provided.) ERIS will also list your name and contact information in our Program Guide and place a link to your website on their website for a 1 year period as an added benefit for becoming a vendor. Your organization name will be listed in our database. If you have a subject matter that you feel would be pertinent to the event you may be allowed to have a 45-minute presentation. (Please contact activities@erisny.org for details.)
- II. Earth Religions In Service, Inc. is not responsible for any injury to any vendor or any vendor employees or property, or for loss by fire, theft, damage, delay or cause whatsoever, while exhibits and merchandise are in transit to or from the event location or while in the event location. The vendor will take full responsibility for any damage, injury or loss to the premises in which the event is held, or to any persons or acts of his/her employees or agents, and the vendor shall indemnify and hold harmless Earth Religions In Service, Inc., Schodack Island State Park, and The People of the State of New York, Executive Department, NYS Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation, Saratoga/Capital District State Park Region, and its officers, agents and assigns from any and all liability which may ensue from any cause whatsoever. Vend at your own risk.
- III. Earth Religions In Service, Inc. is not liable for failure to perform its obligations in the event of Acts of God or any such cause that disrupts the event. The vendor donation will not be refunded if such an event occurs. If the event is canceled for any other reason, a full refund will be issued to vendors within 30 days of notice.

- IV. Vendors will be required to submit a complete listing of all products with pricing that they expect to bring with them and sell at the event. This list should be provided to Earth Religions in Service, Inc. no later than October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2005. If the vendor fails to provide this list by the deadline, they forfeit their space at the event and will not have their vending donation refunded.
- V. **Installation and Dismantling:** Vending tables must be fully set up and all cartons and shipping materials removed by 8:30 am on Saturday, October 15, 2005. All vending tables must be dismantled and removed from the premises by dusk when the park closes. We request that the booths be staffed at all times during the peak hours of the event. No packing of equipment, literature, etc. or dismantling of exhibits will be allowed before 4:30 pm, so as not to disrupt event activities.
- VI. **Restrictions:** All decorative materials shall be flameproof. Exhibits must not obstruct or otherwise interfere with other exhibitors. No space or any part thereof shall be assigned or sublet without written consent of Earth Religions In Service, Inc. Noisy exhibits or those in bad taste will not be permitted. All space is under control of Earth Religions In Service, Inc. and shall not be used for exhibit, persons, advertisements, or other features or action, which does not conform to the high standards of the exhibitions. No weapons, drugs, or drug paraphernalia of any kind may be sold at the event. This includes but is not limited to swords, athames, knives, bolines, etc.
